(funeral director's charges only) This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation. Breakdown of costs is as below:	£2180.00
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements, Chapel of Rest.	£730.00
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into our care.	£270.00
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at our premises at 14 Boston Road, Sleaford.	£410.00
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from Oak Veneer.	£495.00
At a date and time you agree with us, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director'spremises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle.	£275.00
<b>UNATTENDED FUNERAL</b> This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Cremation (our charges including the cremation fee) <sup>2</sup>	£2121.00

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the <b>burial fee</b> . <sup>1</sup> In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee.
